Track Closures

Annual closure period for all Lamington Bush camping areas

Due to the annual closure period, all remote bush camping sites are closed from 1 December to 31 January the following year (2 months), to enable natural regeneration of the sites.

Planned upgrades - Gold Coast Hinterland Great Walks track

Pending favourable weather conditions, planned upgrades to a section of the Gold Coast Hinterland Great Walks track will commence from Monday the 29th of November 2021 to Friday the 4th of March 2022.

As a result, the following area will remain temporarily closed for the duration of the closure. The section of the Gold Coast Hinterland Great Walks track between the northern entrance of the Lower Bellbird circuit and Nerang - Murwillumbah Rd.

Handy hints for new members #2

Some members love to chat on a walk while others like to walk in silence and immerse themselves in

their surroundings. Both are absolutely fine! A few important things to communicate clearly:

1. If you have any health issues that may impact your walk, inform the Leader at the start of

the walk

2. If you need to duck into the bush for a pit stop, inform the tail so they can ensure you re-join

the group. Don't mumble something to the walker beside you – they may not be listening or

think to make sure you return

3. If you find you cannot see or hear the walkers in front of you, call out 'Hey

Bob'. This will

notify the Leader to stop and allow the group to come back together.

Gear is picked up and returned at Club Meetings - 2nd and 4th Wednesdays in every month.


